ABSTRACT

Rasashastra (Indian alchemy) forms the basis of ayurvedic pharmaceutics. It contains information about preparation of medicines from metallic and mineral origin. The present work will highlight the ingredients, actions, preparation of Kasantaka rasa on disease Kasa which is mentioned in Bhaisajyaratnavali in Kasarogadikara. Kasantaka rasa is a form of Khalviyarasayana, it is a combination of metallic, mineral and herbal preparation, which are easily accessible and a simple method of preparation hence an effort is made to review Kasantaka rasa for its Kasahara property.

METHOD OF PREPARATION

- Shuddaparada and Shuddagandaka are taken in clean khalvayantra.
- Kajjali is prepared by using both the drugs by thorough trituration.
- Later all the mentioned ingredients are taken in fine powder form.
- All the fine powders are added one by one and triturated till we get homogeneous mixture.
- After obtaining homogeneous mixture, required quantity of water is added and triturated further to prepare required size and shape of tablets and they are stored in air tight container

Results

After homogeneous mixture of all the herbal drugs with kajjali, the final product obtained was kajjali.
