This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) (this "Understanding") is executed on..... day of themonth of 2025 by and between the **S.S.B.E Society's, Shri Shivayogeeshwar Rural Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital And Research Center Inchal-591102**, here in after referred to as (**SSRAMC**) **Inchal** and **SKE Society's Govindram Seksaria Science College(Autonomous), Tilakwadi, Belagavi, Karnataka, 590006** (here in after referred as **GSS College**)which expression shall, unless repugnant to the subject or context thereof, be deemed to include and mean to its nominees, successors and permitted substitutes or assigns) of the ONE PART

With

SKE Society's Govindram Seksaria Science College, Tilakwadi, Belagavi, Karnataka, 590006, a premier **Autonomous** institute having its place of activity in Belagavi, (hereafter referred as **GSS College**), which expression shall, unless repugnant to the subject or thereof, be deemed to include and mean to its nominees, successors and permitted substitutes or assigns) on another PART either or both of which may be referred to as a "party" or the "Parties" respectively as the context demands.


WHERE AS

- A. The **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College** desire to collaborate in the field of intra and interdisciplinary research, which would provide education/ research program/ faculty, drug/ore testing facilities, student exchange/ academic programs for the mutual benefit by utilizing the expertise and infrastructure existing in both institutions.
- B. Based on the strengths of the **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College**, the **SSRAMC INCHAL** is desirous of collaborating with **GSS College**, which would provide education/training/research program/ faculty, student exchange/ academic programs.

This MOU is to establish hereby a formal understanding of cooperation and friendship which is intended to have further the academic objectives of each institution and to promote better understanding between the faculty and students of **SSRAMC INCHAL** and the faculty and students of **GSS College**.

Background:

S.S.B.E Society's, Shri Shivayogeeshwar Rural Ayurvedic Medical College, is reputed Ayurvedic Medical College which is imparting Ayurvedic Medical education since 1997 & is Celebrating silver Jubilee Year The college is offering graduate and post graduate courses. It has been recognized by NCISM, 06 PG departments with 30 seats and 60 UG seats intake, The teaching hospital with state of the art facilities offers health care service to Society as well as clinical training to students. **SSRAMC College** has the good infrastructure for teaching and research with innovative ideologies among staff.



South Konkan Education Society's GSS College is granted with autonomous status and is a premier educational institute in North Karnataka imparting quality education in science and committed to overall development of students. The college is re-accredited with "A" Grade (3.04 CGPA) by NAAC in 4th Cycle and has ISO 9001-2015 certified laboratory. The college has a proud track record of consistent high results at UG & PG level.

It is engaged in providing quality education through well qualified and dedicated teaching staff. Several departments have shown high quality research by receiving funding from UGC, DST, MoU s etc. Through this MoU these departments will be strengthened further in their researches. The department of Geology, Chemistry, Zoology and Physics are engaging major and minor projects. At present Six PG Courses are available in the institute.

The College has entered MoU with several institutes to name a few- (1) Gogte-Jogalekar college, Ratnagiri; 2) Mining Engineers' Association of India, Belgaum Chapter; 3) National Institute of Hydrology, HDD Rock Region, Belgaum; 4) Shri BMK Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Belagavi; and 5) BVV Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Bagalkote etc.

Under this Memorandum of Understanding, the two institutions will proceed to implement the following endeavors and exchanges of materials and personnel.

ARTICLE I: OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, agree to strengthen, promote and develop co-operations in the field of Indian system of medicine (Ayurveda) and Inter Disciplinary Medicine between the two Institutions.

ARTICLE II: AREAS OF COOPERATION

Cooperation shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of the competent authority of **SSRAMC, INCHAL** and **GSS College**, through such activities or programs as:

Exchange programs:

- Teachers
- UG/PG scholars

Faculty and PG & UG students will be exchanged from both Institutions for different programs viz., Bridge Courses, Workshops, Guest lectures, short time training courses, Seminars, short term research programs and project works etc., as agreed by both Institutions from time to time.



Utilization of research facilities, Joint Research activities

- Faculty and students of both Institutions will be allowed, with prior permission, to utilize the research facilities of the Institutions by prescribed nominal fee if any.
- Both institutions will facilitate the students & faculty by providing access to facilities, guidance of concerned Faculty and Research staff with prior permission and availability.
- Both will promote and facilitate inter-institutional, interdisciplinary research and collaborative research projects by faculty and students of the institutions. Short term research projects, summer research projects etc.

Multi-centric studies

To provide evidence based clinical research Multi-center clinical studies will be taken up. Faculty of both Institutions will be allowed to carry out projects on Collaborative multi-centric studies. Various laboratory facilities, expertise of faculty will be extended.

Continuation of PG/PhD thesis activities

Students of both Institutions will be allowed to have extension of their dissertation/ thesis activities, utilizing facilities, guidance and expertise in these institutions.

Online meetings/On line Guest lectures

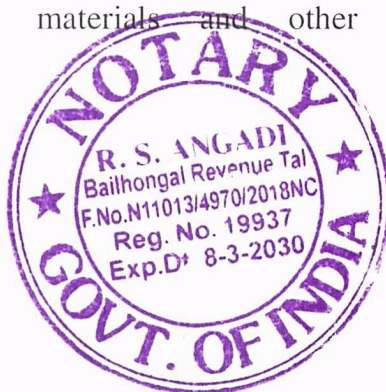
Innovative methods, Information Communication & technology will be used to have better interaction among faculty and students of Universities through Online guest lectures, group interactions through Google Meet/Zoom etc.

Knowledge sharing

Both Institutions will share the knowledge through various academic activities, interaction of faculty, students, online discussions etc. They will allow partner Institution to utilize the databases, educational material, case presentations, practical manuals, dissertations etc., with proper acknowledgement.

Research & Development

- Both Institutions will work in this area of Curriculum development by organizing workshops, brain storming sessions, skill development programs, CME programs collaboratively. They will work to create better teaching methodology, evaluation methods, feedback methods, multimedia utilization in teaching, and simulated practical for Ayurveda.
- Participation in seminars and academic developments
- Planning joint State Level/National/ International Conferences and Workshops,
- Planning joint research publications in the journals.
- Implementation of joint educational programs in each Institution within the identified areas
- Exchange of academic materials and other information with proper acknowledgement.



- The terms of such mutual cooperation and necessary budget for each specific program and activity that is implemented under the terms of this MOU. Each Institution will designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs.

ARTICLE III: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

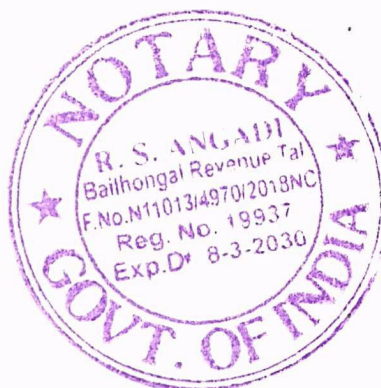
- The financial arrangements to cover expenses for the identified research activities undertaken within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon by both the Parties on a case-by-case basis subject to availability of funds.

ARTICLE IV: PROTECTION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- (a) The protection of intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the national laws, rules and regulations.
- (b) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) above, the intellectual property rights in respect of any technological development, and any products and services development, carried out:
 - (i) Jointly by the parties or research results obtained through the joint activity effort by the Parties, shall be jointly owned by the Parties in accordance with the terms to be mutually agreed upon; and
 - (ii) Solely and separately by the Party or the research results obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party, shall be solely owned by the Party concerned.
- (iii) The terms and conditions in the execution of the research projects shall be decided on case to case basis.

ARTICLE V: CONFIDENTIALITY

- A. Each Party undertakes to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from, or supplied to, the other Party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding;
- B. Both Parties agree that the provisions of this Article shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.



ARTICLE VI: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the Parties. In case, the dispute occurred between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiation or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through Arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties.

ARTICLE VII: ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

This understanding shall come into force and take effect from the date first written above and shall be valid for a period of **FIVE(5) YEARS** and may be renewed thereafter by the parties upon mutual consent.

This understanding may be terminated by either party by providing 60 (Sixty) days written notice to the other party before the beginning of academic year, and the termination would be effective at the end of the notice period.

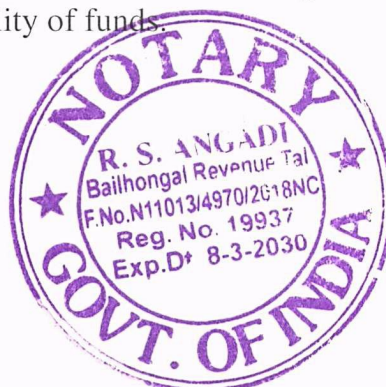
And the termination of the Understanding shall be on the understanding that students/ faculty who have already enrolled in any of the courses / research programs as at the time of termination shall remain entitled to complete their respective courses/ research programs and be eligible to appear assessment conducted by the **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College**.conduced to obtain an award. The obligation of the parties shall continue to be in force during such period, notwithstanding any termination of the Understanding.

Now this MOU Witnesses as follows the Roles and Responsibilities of Either Party

a) Common Responsibilities

- Both institutes have to provide minimal accommodation for students/ faculty of other institute in their institute on nominal costs.
- Students/ faculty have to pay the prescribed fee for the facilities they have used.
- Institutions have to facilitate for easy exchange programs and collaborative work. Administrative hurdles to be cleared at higher level by clear transparent methodology.
- Periodic meeting of coordinators should be arranged to have collaboration and co-operation among faculty of two Institutions.
- Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

b) Roles & Responsibilities of SSRAMC Inchal and GSS College.

● **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College** will facilitate for collaborative activities in teaching, education and research. Both will arrange facilities for conducting activities including in-house and visiting members from academic institutes.

● **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College** shall also arrange to appoint a Coordinator who shall be available at the centre where the programs being offered, in order to facilitate proper coordination between the **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College** covering all aspects relating to conduct of training, research and all other activities coming within the ambit of conducting such programs.

● All students will be governed by the academic regulation of respective parent institutions. i.e. **SSRAMC INCHAL** **GSS College**, as specific to the course or program offered, which shall be provided by the **SSRAMC INCHAL** or **GSS College** to the students at the start of the course/ program.

● **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College** shall maintain both in physical as well as in an electronic format (wherever possible or available) the details (including academic records) of all students/ faculty enrolled for the programs, and shall provide the same to **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College** on request.

● **GSS College** will allow to utilize its facilities for education, teaching and research collaboration, where in the **SSRAMC INCHAL** will allow the all facilities of the research available at **SSRAMC** premises and **CRL** of **SSRAMC**. From both **SSRAMC INCHAL** and **GSS College** faculty will provide guidance time to time.

a) Miscellaneous:

● A coordination committee consisting of the following will monitor the academic and research programs and all related operational activities.

1. Principal – **SSRAMC INCHAL**

2. Vice Principal – **SSRAMC INCHAL**

1. Principal - **GSS College**

2. Two Nominees of **SSRAMC INCHAL**- Members

1. Two nominees of **GSS College** - Members

a) Coordinators of each center

● At **SSRAMC INCHAL**, the Principal will oversee the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.

● At **GSS College**, Principal, **SKE Society's Govindram Seksaria Science College, Tilakwadi, Belagavi**, will oversee the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.





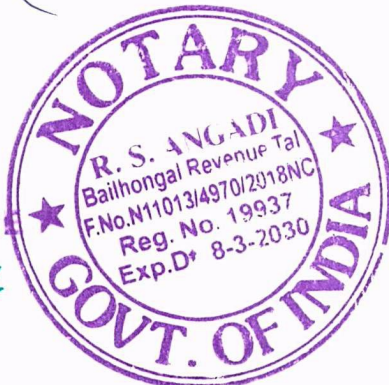
